The privacy practices of Solidarity Experiences Abroad Inc. are in accordance with all federal and provincial laws and regulations. We are compliant with the Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act (PIPEDA). Personal information collected by Solidarity Experiences Abroad Inc. may include such information as your name, e-mail address, municipality, province, and country. This information is collected when you register.

Log Files

As with most other websites, we collect and use the data contained in log files. The information in the log files include your IP (internet protocol) address, your ISP (internet service provider, such as Rogers or Shaw Cable), the browser you used to visit our site (such as Internet Explorer or Firefox), the time you visited our site and which pages you visited throughout our site.

Cookies and Web Beacons

We do use cookies to store information, such as your personal preferences when you visit our site. This could include only showing you a popup once in your visit, or the ability to login to some of our features, such as forums.

You can choose to disable or selectively turn off our cookies or third-party cookies in your browser settings, or by managing preferences in programs such as Norton Internet Security. However, this can affect how you are able to interact with our site as well as other websites. This could include the inability to login to services or programs, such as logging into forums or accounts.

Social Network Connections

By connecting your Social profile from Twitter or Facebook to this website, interactions will exist and posts to your profile at such 3rd party websites may occur. These instances are optional and are at user discretion. Such connections may be disabled by Editing your User Profile on this website or restricting continued access via options provided by aforementioned Social Networks.
